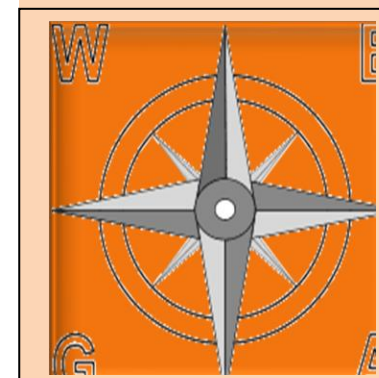

## WEGA's History and the University of Bristol

WEGA was founded as an off-shoot of the extra-mural classes of the Earth Sciences Department of the University of Bristol, with the inaugural meeting held in October 1975. There was great support for WEGA from many members of the Geology Department staff at that time and we continue to have close relations with the Department. Now that the Department has stopped its formal extra-mural activities, WEGA is very well placed to engage with amateur geologists in the local region.
