

Note 1 The Accounts are prepared on a Receipts and Payments basis.

Note 2 There is an amount owing with regards to the Fossil Sessions. If adjusted for this then there would have been a deficit.

Adjusted Deficit £250.46

Comparatives - in the accounts for 2023/24 there were costs that should have been paid in 2022/23. This resulted in a deficit in 2023/24 that should have crystallised in 2022/23.
